Activity 1

Activity 2

Parting the Red Sea

You will need: small Ziploc sandwich bags sticky tape.

¼ cup of corn flour, ¼ cup of water, a few drops of blue food colouring and ¼ cup of vegetable oil.

Put the corn flour, water and food colouring into the bag and seal. Massage the contents until they are all mixed well. Open the bag and pour in the oil. Seal again making sure to remove the excess air from the bag and give the ingredients a good shake to mix. Fold over the top of the bag and stick down with tape to seal securely.

Retell the part of the story where the Israelites are crossing the Red sea and have a go at 'parting the Red sea' using your sandwich bag prop.



Activity 3

Balloon Rocket

You will need: balloons, string, straws (or paper tube), sticky tape
Cut a long piece of string (around 3 metres). Thread the string through the straw. Tie one end of your string to something in the room e.g. the window handle and the other end to a chair (one end of the string should be higher than the other). Make sure the string is held taut. Blow up the balloon but don't tie it. Without letting the balloon deflate tape it to the straw on the string making sure it is secure. Slide the straw and balloon up to the high end of the string. Let go and watch your balloon rocket shoot to the end of the string.

In this experiment we can see the power of the air rushing out of the balloon and propelling the balloon forward.

Can you remember all the ways God's power was shown in the story of Moses' life? What does that tell us about God's power today?



Activity 4

Prayer Activity -God's Power

You will need: small pieces of tissue paper, pens, balloons

Think about who or what you would like to pray for and then write or draw your prayer on the tissue paper.

Blow up a balloon and rub it on your hair. This will build up some static on the balloon!

Hold your tissue prayer close to the balloon and watch as it is pulled onto the balloon and sticks there. Pray that, as the paper sticks to the balloon, God will hold your prayers and that you will see his power at work just as Moses did.
